**NOTES:** All competitors must have a medical certificate not older than 6 months, valid insurance policies and competition accreditation. Each club is responsible for the health condition of its competitors and they perform under the responsibility of their clubs. The organizer of the tournament is not responsible for possible injuries of athletes. **PROTECTIVE GEAR:** Protective equipment according to WKF rules. All female competitors in the categories of cadets, juniors and seniors must have a chest protector in addition to a body protector. All younger competitors in fights (pioneers and hopes) can wear a protective vest over the kimono.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. In the application for team competitions, it is mandatory to specify the competitors who are part of the team.
- 2. Officials at competitions are required to possess the prescribed documents and to present them to the delegate of the Karate Federation of Serbia.
- 3. Competitors and officials will not be allowed to participate in the competition if they do not have or have incomplete documents.
- 4. Competitors perform katas from the list of WKF and KFS katas.
- 5. A competitor in the individual competition can only compete in his age group.
- 6. The competition in the category of cadets, juniors and seniors takes place according to WKF rules, and in the category of youngest competitors, pioneers and hopes according to KFS rules.
- 7. The competition in the categories of cadets, juniors and seniors takes place according to the WKF rules, with the fact that in the individual competition of the age category of cadets there are two classes (B and C) and an absolute level, and in the case of juniors and seniors there is only an absolute level. Class C cadets (yellow and orange belts) perform pre-student and student katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list and can repeat the kata in every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively. Class B cadets (green and blue belts) perform student, teki and master katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list in each round of a new kata, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- 8. For youngest competitors, pioneers and hopes, the competition in performing kata is conducted in six classes: E class (yellow belt), D class (orange belt), C class (green belt), B class (blue belt), A class (brown belt), ABSOLUTE category in kata.
- 9. In individual competitions for younger age categories (youngest competitors, pioneers, hopes), each year represents a separate competition group, while the team competition takes place by age category.
- 10. Competitors from E and D class (yellow and orange belts) perform pre-student and student katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list and can repeat the kata in every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively.
- 11. Competitors from class C (green belts) perform student and teki katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list and can repeat the kata in every fourth round (must know at least three katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively.
- 12. Competitors from class B (blue belts) perform student, teki and master katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list in each round of a new kata, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- 13. Competitors from the A class (brown belts) perform master katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list in each round of a new kata, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- 14. Competitors in the absolute level in the age categories of pioneers and hopes perform katas from the official Kata list, in each round a new kata, and in the age category of youngest competitors perform katas from the official Kata list and can repeat the kata in every fourth round (they must know at least three katas) where the same kata can not be repeated consecutively.
- 15. The competition in individual katas for youngest competitors, pioneers and hopes takes place when both competitors (red and blue) perform the kata at the same time, after which the judges declare the winner.
- 16 There is only one (absolute) level for the team kata for each age.
- 17. In team katas (youngest competitors, pioneers, hopes), one member of the kata team can be from the first younger age category.
- 18. At the team kata for youngest competitors, pioneers and hopes, katas from the official Kata list are performed. Youngest competitors can repeat a kata every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively, and pioneers can repeat a kata every fourth round (must know at least three katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively. In the age category of hopes, competitors perform a new kata in each round, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- 19. The kata team for youngest competitors, pioneers and the hopes team in kata consists of three competitors and the team can be mixed.
- 20. Fights for seniors last three minutes, for juniors, cadets the fight lasts two minutes, while the fight for male and female hopes and pioneers lasts 90 seconds. The fight can last shorter, if the competitor achieves an advantage of 8 points before the end of the time provided for the duration of the fight. The pioneers and hopes fight on a 6x6 m tatami.
- 21. The competition takes place according to the cup system with a full repechage.
- 22. Next to tatami, only trainers and managers in sports equipment with a valid accreditation can be found on the floor.
